

Proceedings of the 2nd meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (KVY) on 31.1.2008.

The 2nd meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) was held on 31.1.2008 in the 2nd Floor Conference Hall of the Secretariat. The Chief Secretary & Chairman of the Committee presided over the meeting. The list of Officers who attended the meeting is at **Annexure-I**.

Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Agriculture Department welcomed the Chairman and all other members and gave a brief presentation of the progress of implementation of RKVY projects in the State. It was revealed that the Central Government has already released Rs. 25.851 Crores under Stream-I and Rs.10.75 Crores under Stream-II through the State budget instead of releasing the funds through the State Nodal Agency. As budget provision was not made in supplementary budget proposals for advance from OCF have been given to Govt. But, in the meanwhile the District Level Agencies have been asked to implement the projects from available funds. Thereafter proposals submitted by various Departments were taken up for consideration and approval.

Principal Secretary, Department of Water Resources presented a proposal under Stream-I for improving water management in Budhabudhiani Minor Irrigation Project in Nayagarh District. The total cost of the project is Rs.552.82 lakhs out of which assistance under RKVY is Rs.511.55 lakhs in 3 years, Rs.82.88 lakhs being the requirement for the first year. The benefit cost ratio is 1.79:1. After detailed discussion, the project was approved to be taken up under RKVY Stream-I.

Principal Secretary, F. & A.R.D. Department presented the project submitted by OMFED for development of dairy in Puri, Khurda, Nayagarh and Boudh districts with a total project outlay of Rs.468.73 lakhs to be implemented over a period of 3 years. The requirement for 1st year is Rs.211.46 lakhs. After detailed discussion, the project was approved. He also presented the project for development of Chipilima Farm for Rs.52.00 lakhs. After detailed discussion the projects were approved.

He next presented the project for upgradation and modernization of Chandrabhaga Shrimp Hatchery at Konark as Multi- species Hatchery for an amount of Rs.270.00 lakhs. It was further decided that a management system would be put in position to enable the hatchery to be sustainable. Necessary actions would be taken by Department of F & A R D. After detailed discussion, the project was approved.

Dean, Research, OUAT presented the proposal for strengthening of Research Station at Bhubaneswar with Rs.370.00 lakhs. Chief Secretary opined that OUAT should submit detailed proposal for development of Semiliguda Farm. He also suggested that all projects should accompany outcome budget in future. Principal Secretary, F.& A.R.D. Department suggested that OUAT should take up production of quality planting materials of turmeric and ginger. Agriculture Production Commissioner suggested that all the projects should indicate deliverables with indicators which can be monitored in future. After detailed discussion, the project was approved.

Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Agriculture presented the proposal for establishment of Seed Testing Laboratories at Sambalpur, Balasore and Barachana by OSSCA with an outlay of Rs.565.60 lakh. Commissioner-cum-Secretary, ST & SC Devt. Department suggested that Seed Testing Laboratories may be established in Kalahandi which will cater to the need of the District. Dr. O.N. Srivastav suggested to disallow the Training Hall component of the proposal. The proposal was approved without provision of Training Hall, which finds mention on the budget.

The proposal of Agriculture Department for establishment of Seed Processing Plant at Bolangir, Boudh and Nawarangapur in place of the earlier approved proposals at Gajapati, Kendrapara and Jharsuguda was approved.

A presentation on Draft Operational Guidelines was made for implementation of the Scheme under RKVY by the Consultant. Agriculture Production Commissioner clarified on a number of issues relating to Operationalization of Guidelines and also emphasized on a comprehensive guidelines for implementation of RKVY for effective result. It was decided that all Implementing Agencies shall follow the guidelines.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
