**Minutes of the 18th State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY held on
09.10.2015 in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat under the Chairmanship of
Chief Secretary, Odisha**

18th State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY was held on 09.10.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat at 12.30 P.M. The list of members & other participants who attended the meeting is placed at Annexure-I.

At the outset Principal Secretary to Govt., Agriculture Department welcomed the Chairman, Addl. Commissioner (Crops), Gol, Senior Research Officer, NITI Ayoga, of Gol and other members present in the meeting and gave an overview of the scheme. The details of the discussion are as follows:

(1) Confirmation of minutes of the last meeting of SLSC held on 10.06.2015


The minutes of the meeting of 17th SLSC held on 10.06.2015 were circulated to all the members vide Agriculture Department letter No.9534/Ag. Dt.26.06.2015. Since no comments were received, SLSC confirmed the minutes of the meeting of 17th SLSC.

(2) Physical status of the projects from 2007-08 to 2014-15

Principal Secretary, Agriculture informed that 447 nos. of projects have been implemented since inception of RKVY scheme, out of which 329 nos of projects have been completed and uploaded in RDMIS. The Chief Secretary and Chairman, SLSC directed the Implementing Agencies to submit project completion details of the completed projects immediately for uploading in RDMIS failing which release of fund for other ongoing projects of the concerned Implementing Agencies will be withheld. The Chief Secretary cum Chairman, SLSC suggested that all the Implementing Agencies should complete the projects as per the time line of the sanctioned projects. A separate presentation on delayed projects by different agencies should be made on this aspect in the next meeting.

(3) Financial progress under RKVY for 2007- 08 to 2014-15

Principal Secretary, Agriculture stated that full Utilization Certificates for fund received during 2007-08 to 2013-14 have been submitted to Gol. An amount of Rs.48207.00 lakh has been received for the year 2014-15 against the allocated amount of the Rs.50413.00 lakh and U.Cs for an amount of


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Rs.44765.60 lakh have been submitted to GoI. The State has released Rs.50413.00 lakh to the Implementing Agencies for timely execution of the new as well as ongoing projects out of State budgetary allocation of Rs.55000.00 lakh. All the implementing Agencies should submit 100% U.Cs against the released amount for the year of 2014-15 by the end of October,2015 so as to enable the State is getting the 2nd installment amount from GoI in time.

(4) Financial Position & Requirement of fund for 2015-16

Govt. of India have allocated Rs.21820.00 lakh under RKVY (Normal) and Rs.18400.00 lakh under RKVY (Sub Scheme – BGREI) totaling to Rs.40220.00 lakh with 50:50 sharing for the year 2015-16. This is a drastic cut in the allocation under RKVY. Principal Secretary suggested that GoI may be requested to allocate more funds under Normal RKVY in comparison to the previous year. The Chief Secretary desired that the matter may be taken up with Govt. of India.


GoI have released an amount of Rs 10055.00 lakh, for the year 2015-16 against which U.C.s for an amount Rs.8338.05 lakh has been submitted to GoI so far.

(5) Bringing Green Revolution to Eastern India (BGREI):

During 2015-16, only one sub scheme i.e, Bringing Green Revolution in Eastern India (BGREI) is being implemented. Under BGREI programme, Govt. of India have allocated Rs.18400.00 lakh with 50:50 sharing pattern.(State share 50 % & Central share 50 %). GoI have released Rs.4600.00 lakh as 1st installment for implementation of the programme. The Principal Secretary, Agriculture apprised the house about the crop loss due to the moisture stress condition during the current Kharif season. To compensate the loss of the farmers it was decided to increase the area under cluster demonstrations and enhance the pulse production in the State. The Committee suggested that GoI may be requested for additional sanction of Rs.25.00 Crore over & above Rs.18400.00 lakh under BGREI for the pupose. The Commissioner-cum-DA&FP(O) was advised to furnish the revised action plan to GoI for consideration.

(6) De-sanction of Projects

The following 6 nos. of project proposals of different Implementing Agencies were discussed in detail for de-sanction and the same were de-sanctioned.


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

(7)Sanction of new project proposals

Principal Secretary, Agriculture informed that in two meetings of State Level Project Screening Committee held on 08.07.2015 & 29.08 2015, a total of 34 nos of project proposals were recommended for sanction in the SLSC. The views of GoI for 17 nos. of project proposals recommended by the SLPSC in its meeting held on 08.07.2015 have been received and for pending the rest 17 project proposals GoI requires more time to scrutinize these proposals.

Since some of the project proposals are time bound in nature due to seasonality and need to provide support to the farmers in the prevailing moisture stress condition, the following 6 nos. of project proposals have been approved by the Chief Secretary & Chairman SLSC to ensure timely implementation:-

- (A) The following Project proposals submitted by Commissioner-cum-DA & FP(O)& Director, Horticulture, Odisha were ratified by the Committee.

(B) Discussion of New Project proposals by SLSC.

OLIC

- 1) **Extension and distribution system of Lift Irrigation projects with the cost of Rs. 2113.55 lakh.**

The project is supported under NMSA guidelines. The Committee discussed the project in detail and sanctioned the same by limiting the project cost to Rs.1013.16 lakh only as per the comments/ observation of the Gol. The M.D. OLIC was instructed to revise the project proposal with respect the cost norms @ Rs 12000 per ha.

OMFED

- 2) **Creation of additional 80 TR Refrigeration Facility at Bhubaneswar dairy, Chandrashekharpur with the cost of Rs. 205.80 lakh.**
- 3) **Up gradation of quality control laboratories of OMFED with the cost of Rs.1057.13 lakh.**
- 4) **Creation of cold storage facility at Bhubaneswar dairy, Chandrashekharpur with the cost of Rs.162.75 lakh.**

All the above 3 projects of OMFED were discussed in detail and the committee advised to resubmit the proposals after complying with the Gol observations.

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Director Fisheries

- 5) **Project proposal on assistance to fisherman for livelihood development with the cost of Rs.2040.00 lakh.**

The project was discussed in detail with regards to comments of GoI. The Committee sanctioned the project limiting the project cost to provide 25% assistance out of RKVY Scheme. Another 25% assistance may be given to the beneficiaries out of State Plan. The Director, Fisheries was advised to revise the project proposal/cost accordingly before issue of sanction order. It was also decided not to support project for supply of boat & net to fishermen whose livelihood may be improved through culture fisheries or other vocations which are more sustainable.

Director AH & VS

- 6) **Conservation and improvement of Kendrapada Sheep with the cost of Rs.50.60 lakh.**

The Committee discussed the project with respect to observation of GoI not to support. However in view of excellent quality of the breed shown in research by OUAT, the Committee sanctioned the project in principle, but the funds will be released after filing of application for registration of the breed.

- 7) **Control of Theileriosis in dairy cattle of Odisha with the cost of Rs.1906.00 lakh.**

The project was discussed in detail with regards to comments of GoI and was sanctioned. The Chairman advised the Director, of AH & VS to recast the project cost limiting the vaccine & medicine cost to 50 % with balance being recovered from beneficiary farmers and also keeping in view the comments of the GoI.

- 8) **Use of poultry manure as fertilizer for crop production with the cost of Rs.277.95 lakh.**

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned with a suggestion that it should be implemented in demonstration mode in the agricultural fields of farmers (near poultry farms) to be identified by Agriculture Department and proper documentation about benefits in terms of productivity & cost of cultivation should be made. KVKs (OUAT) may also be involved during implementation of the project.

OSSC

- 9) **Project proposal for construction of seed storage godowns with the cost of Rs.2404.10 lakh.**

The Committee discussed the project in detail and sanctioned with a suggestion to utilize the Godowns for storing mainly the non-paddy seeds.


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MARKFED

- 10) Renovation and modernisation of Rayagada cold storage of MARKFED with the cost of Rs.61.86 lakh.**

The Committee discussed the project in detail with respect to comments of GoI and sanctioned with a suggestion that the Director, Horticulture and TDCC should commit in writing to complete the repairs and to run the cold storage within 3 months. After getting assurance from TDCC regarding utilization of the Cold Storage, the funds will be released to TDCC instead of MARKFED.

Co-operation

- 11) Renovation of cold storage at Satasankha, Puri with the cost of Rs.45.30 lakh.**

The Committee sanctioned the project after detailed discussion.

Director Horticulture

- 12) Project proposal on bamboo shade net house to be used for mushroom cultivation in Ganjam district with the cost of Rs.119.00 lakh.**

The proposal was discussed in detail and the Committee approved the project. The cost of bamboo shade nets being less costly, specifications for use in precision agriculture may be developed in consultation with OUAT and these may be circulated among the field officers/farmers & district Collectors for its use.

DA & FP (O)

- 13) Establishment of automatic weather station networks in Odisha with the cost of Rs.450.00 lakh.**

- 14) Supply of Tools for Crop Cutting Experiments with the cost of Rs.180.92 lakh.**

Both the projects were discussed in detail and sanctioned by the Committee.

(C) The Project proposals recommended by SLPSC in its meeting held on 29.08.2015 for consideration for sanction in SLSC

DA & FP (O)

- (1) Project proposal for up gradation of State Seed Testing Laboratory, Bhubaneswar with the cost of Rs.597.00 lakh.**

The project proposal was discussed by the Committee and approved in principle. However, funds will be released after getting the comments from GoI & after approval of CS in file.

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During the discussion the Chairman suggested that OUAT should come up with new proposal for setting up 3 Nos. of Seed Testing Labs in the KVKs.

OMFED

(2) Project proposal on procurement and marketing of Binjharpuri milk with the cost of Rs.427.37 lakh.

(3) Project proposal on procurement and marketing of Chilika Buffalo milk with the cost of Rs.185.90 lakh.

Above 2 projects were discussed by the Committee and were approved in principle. The funds will be released after getting the comments from GoI.

The projects as mentioned below could not be discussed and deferred to the next SLSC after receipt of the comments from GoI.

The Chairman suggested to include the training of progressive farmers in the ATMA Cafeteria. The Director, IMAGE was directed to recast the Action Plan accordingly.

(9) Miscellaneous Issues

- i. The Commissioner cum Director Agriculture apprised the Committee that some blocks of Balasore district have been affected by moisture stress. He suggested to include this district in the approved project "Incentivizing Cultivation of New Cultivar of Mustard in P-P-P endeavor" under RKVY during the year 2015-16 Rabi with area of 2500 ha for which an




















