Minutes of the 23rd State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), held on 30.10.2017 at 12.30 P.M. in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha

1. The 23rd State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) was held at 12.30 P.M. on 30.10.2017 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat. The list of participants is placed at **Annexure-I**.
2. Initiating the discussion, Principal Secretary, Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment (A&FE) welcomed the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC, Joint Secretary, Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare (AC&FW), Government of India (GoI) as well as other members, present in the meeting. He presented a brief overview of the scheme. Thereafter, agenda wise discussions were taken up.
3. **Confirmation of minutes of the last meeting of SLSC held on 07.06.2017:** The minutes of the 22nd SLSC meeting, held on 07.06.2017 were circulated to the members vide Agriculture Department letter No.9975/Ag. Dt.22.06.2017. SLSC confirmed the minutes of the 22nd SLSC meeting.
4. **Discussion on Action Taken Report on decision in last SLSC:**
During 22nd SLSC, eight projects of Directorate of Fisheries, 4 projects of Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services (AH & VS) & two projects of Odisha State Cooperative and Milk Producers' Federation Ltd (OMFED) were sanctioned in principle subject to approval of Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairies and Fisheries (AHD&F), Government of India. Since these projects were turned down by AHD&F, GoI, Secretary Department of Fisheries and Animal Resource Development (F&ARD) suggested the these projects may be de-sanctioned. The Committee agreed to de-sanction these projects. Chief Secretary suggested that in future, projects would be placed for approval of SLSC only after obtaining all the requisite clearances from relevant departments/agencies.
5. Special Secretary, Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment (A & FE) made a presentation and highlighted the followings:

5.1. Physical status of the projects from 2007-08 to 2016-17

Under RKVY, about 615 projects have been implemented since 2007-08 till 2016-17 out of which 417 projects have been completed and uploaded in RDMIS. Chief Secretary and Chairman, SLSC directed the implementing agencies to take adequate measures for completion of all ongoing projects and submit the completion reports expeditiously.

5.2. Steps have been taken for Geo tagging of the assets/infrastructures created under RKVY in the Bhuvan Portal. Till date, 8508 assets have been geo tagged out of which 4377 are moderated and rest are to be moderated soon. This was appreciated by the Committee.

5.3. Financial progress under RKVY

5.3.1. Complete Utilization Certificates (UC) for funds received during 2007-08 to 2014-15 have been submitted to Gol and the accounts have been squared up for these years. However, there are issues of pending UCs for the year 2015-16 and 2016-17. Joint Secretary AC&FW stated that for release of second installment of RKVY during 2017-18, the State needs to submit 100% UCs for 2016-17 and 60% UCs for 2017-18.

5.3.2. Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC advised all the departments/ implementing agencies to submit 100 % U.Cs of previous years for 2015-16 & 2016-17 and 60% U.C.s for the current financial year (2017-18) immediately.

5.4. Discussion on new project proposals:

Following new project proposals, recommended by State Level Project Screening Committee (SLPSC) were discussed in the meeting. Comments/ observations of Gol were also noted and decisions were taken as follows:

5.4.1. Director Agriculture and Farm Production (DA&FP)

5.4.1.1. **Increasing irrigation potential through individually owned Bore wells & Cluster Micro River Lifts with the cost of Rs. 3532.00 lakh.**

5.4.1.2. **Popularization of Agriculture Machineries / Implements in the State with the cost of Rs. 2380.00 lakh.**

The Committee sanctioned these two projects.

5.4.2. Odisha University of Agriculture Technology (OUAT)

5.4.2.1. Surveillance and monitoring of common diseases of ducks of Odisha with the cost of Rs. 168.10 lakh. The Committee approved this project.

5.4.2.2. Establishment of Geo-Spatial Technology Centre for Multipurpose Agricultural Use with the cost of Rs. 225.00 lakh. The Committee approved this project.

5.4.2.3. Development of Nutri-Smart Village for Combating Malnutrition in Tribal Districts of Odisha with the cost of Rs. 166.00 lakh. AC&FW, Gol recommended the proposal with the comment that the component for POL may be excluded. Special Secretary A&FE stated that expenses on POL was not admissible under RKVY. The Committee sanctioned the project with the observation that the component on expenses would be excluded from the DPR. The DPR was accordingly modified.

5.4.3. AH & VS

5.4.3.1. Supporting Operations of 310 Integrated Livestock Dev (ILD) Centers under Cattle Breed & Small Ruminant Improvement Project (CBSRIP) in 12 Districts of Odisha for providing Breeding and Veterinary Support Services to Livestock at the doorsteps of the farmers with the cost of Rs. 660.00 lakh.

5.4.3.2. Construction of Central Store for Medicines & Biological at Phulnakhara, Cuttack with the cost of Rs. 282.60 lakh. The SLSC sanctioned these two projects for implementation.

5.4.3.3. Establishment and Strengthening of Veterinary Hospitals & Dispensaries (ESVHD) with the cost of Rs. 949.00 lakh. The above project was sanctioned by the SLSC after thorough discussion with reference to comments/observations of Gol. Chief Secretary desired that while selecting Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries, duplication should be avoided. The Committee sanctioned the project.

5.4.4. Odisha State Cashew Development Corporation (OSDC)

5.4.4.1. Strengthening of cashew nurseries of OSDC Ltd with the cost of Rs. 344.80 lakh. The SLSC sanctioned the project proposal. Chief Secretary desired that construction work should be as per CPWD norm or State PWD cost norm which should not exceed the CPWD schedule of rate.

5.4.5. Soil Conservation & Watershed Development

5.4.5.1. Proposed water harvesting structures under RKVY with the cost of Rs. 4820.00 lakh. This project proposal was discussed by the Committee with reference to the observation & Comments of Gol and the Committee sanctioned the project.

5.4.6. FISHERIES

5.4.6.1. Renovation of Departmental fish farm for enhancement of Fish seed production thorough RKVY with the cost of Rs. 420.00 lakh.

5.4.6.2. Renovation of Government fish farm, Kausalyagang for enhancing fingerling production with the cost of Rs. 880.72 lakh.

5.4.6.3. Promotion of Intensive Shrimp Farming in Coastal Districts of Odisha under RKVY with the cost of Rs. 1010.00 lakh.

5.4.6.4. Ornamental fish production in Mayurbhanj, Khurda and Ganjam district with the cost of Rs. 155.31 lakh.

5.4.6.5. Promotion of Advanced Fingerling Nurseries and Better Management Practices for Doubling the Carp Farm Productivity in Odisha with the cost of Rs. 299.00 lakh.

All the above 5 project proposals were discussed by the SLSC with reference to the comments/observation of Gol and the Committee sanctioned above 5 projects. Further, the Chairman desired that an evaluation study may be taken up for assessing success of small fish cultivation in the state. Agriculture Production Commissioner (APC) suggested that there is ample scope for cultivation of small indigenous fish in our state. The Department may take appropriate strategy in this regard.

5.4.7. OMFED

5.4.7.1. Installation of automatic milk collection unit at DCS level under RKVY with the cost of Rs. 154.04 lakh. The project proposal was discussed by the Committee with reference to comments/observation of Gol and the Committee sanctioned the project.

5.4.7.2. Renovation and modernization of old dairy plants of OMFED with the cost of Rs. 513.08 lakh. The SLSC discussed the project with reference to comments/observation of Gol and the Committee sanctioned the project excluding the DG set component for implementation. The DPR was accordingly modified.

5.4.7.3. Support to DCS for Dairy Development Activities with the cost of Rs. 84.27 lakh. The above project proposal was discussed by the Committee keeping in view of the observation of Gol and the SLSC sanctioned the above project excluding the Milking machine component. The DPR was accordingly modified.

5.4.8. Odisha Lift Irrigation Corporation (OLIC)

5.4.8.1. Extension of Distribution system of community lift irrigation projects in Odisha with a cost of Rs. 962.5188 lakh. The SLSC sanctioned the project proposal.

5.4.9. Co-operation

5.4.9.1. Strengthening and renovation of Aska Cooperative sugar Industries Ltd, under RKVY with the cost of Rs. 290.50 lakh. The Committee discussed the project proposal in detail with reference to the comments/observation of Gol and sanctioned the project excluding the modernization of sugar plant. Commissioner cum Secretary, Co-operation opined that sugar cane production and processing are inter linked. Processing included investment in plant and machinery. Moreover, earlier, renovation work was taken up in Sugar Industries of the State under RKVY. It was decided that Co-operation department may take up the issue with Gol expeditiously. Accordingly, the DPR was modified and the component for sugar plantation was sanctioned.

5.4.10. Agricultural Promotion and Investment Corporation of Odisha Limited (APICOL)

5.4.10.1. Setting up of Mini Coffee Curing plant at Koraput on PPP mode with the cost of Rs. 150.00 lakh. The proposal was discussed with reference to the comments of Gol. As Coffee plantation is not addressed in AC&FW, Gol and it was handled in Ministry of Commerce Gol the project could not be taken up under RKVY. Chief Secretary opined that this project was located in a tribal district and had livelihood implications, efforts should be made to implement the project. MD APICOL stated that the project to establish Coffee curing unit on PPP mode. The Committee suggested that AC&FW may obtain a no objection certificate (NOC) from Ministry of Commerce, Gol for further consideration.

5.4.11. ICAR-NRRI

5.4.11.1. IT enabled self-sufficient sustainable seed system for rice (4S4R) in Cuttack district with the cost of Rs. 432.04 lakh. The project was discussed with reference to comments/observation of Gol and the SLSC sanctioned the project while excluding the operational & contingency expenses. The DPR was accordingly modified.

5.4.11.2. Development and demonstration of integrated farming system for livelihood security of small and marginal farmers in coastal Odisha with the cost of Rs. 219.28 lakh. The SLSC sanctioned the project proposal.

5.4.12. Director Horticulture

5.4.12.1. Cultivation and processing of lemongrass in Koraput, Gajapati, Mayurbhanj and Boudh district with the cost of Rs. 373.00 lakh. The above project proposal was discussed by the Committee with reference to the comments/observation of Gol and the SLSC sanctioned the above project.

5.4.12.2. Establishment of Integrated Bee development Centre in Nayagarh district with the cost of Rs. 898.87 lakh. The above project proposal was discussed by the SLSC keeping in view of the Comments/ observation of Gol & the SLSC on hold the project with a suggestion to obtain clearance from NBB of Ministry of Agriculture & FW, Gol.

5.4.13. Sub Scheme

5.4.13.1. Director Horticulture

5.4.13.1.1. Peri-urban Horticulture development in Bhubaneswar with the cost of Rs. 394.00 lakh. The above project proposal was not recommended by AC&FW, Gol since the project proposal did not mention the requisite forward and backward linkages. The Committee advised that Director, Horticulture may recast the DPR accordingly and obtain the clearance from MIDH Division of Gol for further consideration.

5.4.13.2. DA & FP

5.4.13.2.1 Targeted Rice Fallow Areas for pulses & Oil seeds (TRFA) with the cost of Rs. 4180.40 lakh.

5.4.13.2.2. Crop Diversification Programme (CDP) with the cost of Rs. 4.08 lakh.

The Action Plan of the above two sub schemes have been approved by Gol for the year 2017-18. The SLSC discussed the above two projects and sanctioned the same. Hence Director, Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha (DA & FP (O) was requested to submit the DPR as per the template of RKVY with the approved Action Plan immediately.

The list of projects, sanctioned by the Committee is given in ANNEXURE-II

5.5. Other matters/issues

5.5.1. De-sanctioning of the project.

Following projects, sanctioned by earlier SLSC were de-sanctioned by the Committee due to reason mentioned against the projects.

5.5.2. Secretary F&ARD stated that the department is not able to implement two Projects namely; (i) "Demonstration and Development of Aquaculture Crop Based Integrated Farming System in waterlogged wasteland areas of Puri District, Odisha.(NMPS)" and (ii) Aquaculture Development through integrated approach in Gop Block of Puri District.(NMPS) due to change of subsidy pattern under blue revolution guidelines. Commissioner-cum-Secretary, F&ARD requested that subsidy norms as per Blue Revolution guidelines may be adopted for these projects. Chief Secretary cum Chairman SLSC agreed to the proposal while keeping the total project outlay unchanged.

5.5.3. DA&FP(O) stated that under BGREI programme during 2016-17, due to Gram Panchayat election in the state, new projects could not be taken up resulting a balance amount of Rs 3257.70 lakh remained unspent. This matter was moved to Gol. As per the suggestion by Gol, the state has submitted the revised action plan for the unspent amount of Rs 3257.70 lakh towards site specific activities under BGREI 2016-17 to Gol to utilise during 2017-18. This was discussed & the Committee approved the proposal for implementation during the year 2017-18.

5.5.4. DA&FP stated that two projects were recast as per decision of the 22nd SLSC. The projects were, (i) Alternative seed systems for Rain fed Crops Enhance productivity, Access and supply of improved variety seeds; (ii) Integrated farming systems model for income Enhancement for small and marginal farmers in Koraput region with project cost Rs.118.22 lakh &

Rs.159.95 lakh respectively. These proposals were discussed and approved by the Committee.

5.5.5. Director, Horticulture has requested for consideration of certain modification in components of following projects approved earlier by the SLSC.

5.5.5.1. Development of Nandanbana Farm, Khandapada, Nayagarh approved in 19th SLSC:

The fund earmarked for construction of training hall cum extension center may be enhanced to Rs.65.50 lakh. This additional expenditure will be met from the savings of some other components while keeping the total project cost constant. The Chief Secretary stated that expenditure under each component should be as per the approved rates. Director Horticulture clarified that the schedule of rates was followed scrupulously. The Committee agreed with the proposal.

5.5.5.2. Development of Regional Coconut Research Station Farm, Sakhigopal approved in 17th SLSC.

The savings from civil work will be utilized for meeting additional requirement for installation of transformer and electrification network as per the requirement, communicated by Puri Electricity Division. The Committee agreed with the proposal.

5.5.5.3. Integrated development of floricultural market at Bhubaneswar approved in 13th SLSC; change of site.

The change of proposed site for floriculture market at Unit-IX, Kusum Batika to Ekamrakanan farm was allowed by the Committee.

5.5.5.4. Skill development of rural entrepreneurs approved in the 20th SLSC.

The proposal for changing the HTI, Kalinga was not accepted by the Committee. Chief Secretary desired that infrastructure, created in tribal districts such as Kandhamal may be made operational expeditiously, if necessary by engaging additional manpower.

6. Principal Secretary, Agriculture & FE stated that in future, some big projects can be taken up in PPP mode under RKVY. Such projects were implemented in other States where RKVY funds were used to meet the viability gap funding for selected PPP projects. This would facilitate significantly higher investment in the projects by leveraging limited funds, available under RKVY. Moreover, evaluation of a few RKVY projects will be carried out by third party. Joint Secretary, Gol informed that, Gol is emphasizing on creation of Farmer Producer Organization (FPO) as per the Company Act. About Rs 44.0 lakh for a group of 1000 farmers is available for formation, registration training of FPOs. The JS also opined that















several States such as Maharashtra and Karnataka have taken up projects in PPP mode under RKVY to strengthen marketing linkages. Chief Secretary stated that A&FE department may take up projects in PPP mode under RKVY. He also agreed that impact evaluation studies may be carried out for selected RKVY projects.

7. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and the members present.


















