**Minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY held on 20.11.2019 at 12.30 P.M. in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Hall of LokSeva Bhawan under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha**

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The 29<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY was held on 20.11.2019 at 12.30P.M. under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Hall of LokSeva Bhawan. The list of participants is placed at **Annexure-I**.

At the outset, Principal Secretary, Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment welcomed the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC, as well as other members present in the meeting. Initiating the discussion, agenda wise power-point presentation was made by the Additional Secretary, Agriculture & FE as below:

**1. Confirmation of minutes of the last meeting of SLSC held on 11.07.2019**

The minute of the meeting of 28<sup>th</sup> SLSC held on 11.07.2019 was circulated to all the members vide Agriculture Department letter No.14790/Ag. Dt.16.08.2019. The SLSC confirmed the minute of the meeting of 28<sup>th</sup> SLSC.

**2. Physical status of the projects from 2007-08 to 2019-20**

Under RKVY, about 766 projects have been implemented from 2007-08 to 2019-20 out of which 505 projects have been completed and uploaded in RDMIS. Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC directed the implementing agencies to complete the on-going projects and submit the completion details of the projects immediately.

**3. Financial progress under RKVY**

1. The financial position of 2018-19 and 2019-20 was apprised to the Committee. For the FY 2018-19, 89.27% of the released amount has been spent by different Implementing Agencies(IAs) and submitted the UC. The major defaulters are OUAT and OSDMA. The Chairman of the committee asked VC, OUAT to sort out their internal matters without bringing it before the Committee again and again asked to intimate the Nodal Department within a week time whether OUAT can spend the amount within a month or not. If not, then he must refund the released amount immediately and request for de-sanctioning of the projects.

No representative from OSDMA was present in the meeting. The Chairman of SLSC suggested Principal Secretary, Department of Agriculture and FE to ask for physical and financial status from OSDMA in order to know the actual progress in the project and apprise the Committee in its next meeting.

2. Similarly, for the FY 2019-20, 66.49% of the released amount has been spent by different Implementing Agencies(IAs) and submitted the UC accordingly. The Chairman advised all the IAs to expedite the execution process.

**4. Proposal for Time Extension**

1. The proposals for time extension of different projects as approved in principle by SLPSC held on 19.09.2019 were placed before the SLSC for approval. The list is as follows;

1. Design & Develop Affordable, Movable, Solar Photo Voltaic (SPV) Water Pumping System by DA &FP(O) till 31st March 2020.
2. Special Programme for Promotion of Integrated Farming in Tribal Areas by DA &FP(O) till 31st March 2021.
3. New seed Testing Laboratory at Berhampur by DA &FP(O) till 31st March 2020.
4. Establishment of State Organic Fertilizer Testing Laboratory by DA &FP(O) till 31st March 2020.
5. Establishment of 50000 new dairy plant at Sonepur by OMFED till 31st March 2020.
6. UP gradation of Tangi Dairy Plant from 10 TLPD to 30 TLPD by OMFED till 31st March 2020.
7. Establishment State of Art Referral Laboratory at Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex by Director, AH & VS till 31st March 2020.
8. Construction of Central Store for Medicines & Biological at Phulnakhara, Cuttack by Director, AH & VS till 31st March 2020.
9. Establishment and Strengthening of Veterinary Hospital & Dispensaries (ESVHD) by Director, AH & VS till 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.

The Committee discussed about the reasons behind delay in execution of the projects. It approved the proposed time extension with condition that no further time extension will be allowed beyond the stipulated time. Further, the Chairman asked the implementing agencies to finish the old projects immediately without making further delay.

**5. V.C., OUAT has requested for time extension of the following projects till March 2020, which were approved by SLPSC by held on 19.09.2019.**

1. Strengthening of Centre of Pulses Research at Berhampur (FY 2016-17).
2. Holistic development of RRTTS, Keonjhar (FY 2016-17).
3. Surveillance and monitoring of common diseases of ducks of Odisha (FY 2018-19).
4. Establishment of Centre of Excellence on Horticulture & Agri-livelihoods at KVK, Keonjhar (FY 2016-17).
5. Strengthening of Bio-Technology and Tissue Culture Centre, OUAT (FY 2016-17).
6. Holistic development of RRTTS Bhawanipatna (FY 2016-17).
7. Infrastructure support to OUAT KVKs (FY 2016-17).
8. Collection, Screening, Purification and Improvement of Greengram and Blackgram Land Races of Odisha (FY 2018-19).
9. Holistic development of RRTTS, Chipilima, Samabalpur (FY 2016-17).
10. Establishment of Pulse Breeder Seed Processing and Storage Facilities at OUAT (FY 2018-19).
11. Infrastructure Dev. At RRTTSS, Umerkote, Nabarangpur for Maize Research (FY 2018-19).

The Committee approved the time extension proposals and asked V.C., OUAT to complete all the above projects by March 2020 without asking for further extension.

**6. Proposal of Director, Horticulture, Odisha:**

1. **Promotion of VIUC around Bhubaneswar, Rourkela and Berhampura cities under RKVY:** Director, Horticulture had proposal to utilize the unspent amount of Rs.208.92 lakh for renovation of Mushroom Units in cyclone affected areas (Rs. 50.50 Lakhs) and Restoration of Root and Tuber Crops in cyclone affected areas (Rs. 141.42 Lakhs).
2. Development of CoE, Deras,: Director, Horticulture had proposed to utilize the unutilized amount under the project (Rs. 139.32 lakh) for restoration of the damages caused by cyclone FANI to the infrastructures present in the same locations.

**The Committee approved both the proposals of Director, Horticulture with suggestion to complete the work by March 2020 positively.**

#### **7. ICAR-CIFA**

1. CIFA had requested for revalidation of the budget and extension of the time period of the following 3 projects up to March, 2020.
  1. Establishment of incubation centre for micro enterprises in fresh water aquaculture for Odisha.
  2. Establishment of aquaculture field school and technical service centre of fresh water aquaculture in Odisha.
  3. Developing and Strengthening Demonstration Units for transfer of Rural Livelihood Technologies by KrishiVigyan Kendra – Khordha.

**The Committee approved the proposals of budget revalidation and time extension upto March, 2020. No further extension will be allowed beyond March, 2020.**

#### **8. Fisheries (OPDC)**

1. Establishment of mini fish feed manufacturing plant at OPDC, FSHP on PPP mode with 50% RKVY assistance.
2. Establishment of One stop Aqua shop with multipurpose go-down and flake ice machine at Rahama, Jagatsinghpur in Odisha on PPP Mode with 50% RKVY assistance.

The above 2 project proposals were approved in 26<sup>th</sup> SLSC held on 02.02.2019 with 50% RKVY assistance for implementation on PPP mode. However, Director, Fisheries expressed inability to implement the projects in PPP mode, since no private entrepreneur or beneficiaries have turned up for investment.

The Committee discussed the proposal with reference to the recommendation of SLPSC held on 19.09.19 and approved 100% assistance under RKVY, keeping the total project cost intact and reducing the volume of operation.

Also, the Committee asked all the Implementing Agencies to explore the opportunity of private investment and then submit PPP project instead of submitting unplanned projects.

#### **9. Director of Fisheries**

1. Sale of ready-to-eat fish through Fish on Wheels (FISHFED), sanctioned in FY 2018-19. With a project cost of Rs. 153.00 lakhs
2. Director, Fisheries had proposed to divert the sanctioned and released amount of Rs.153.00 under the above mentioned project of FISHFED to another sanctioned project, 'Renovation of Govt. Fish Farm, Kausalyaganj for

enhancing Fingerling Production under RKVY', since private entrepreneurs have not turned up to execute the project in PPP mode.

Realising the difficulties in project implementation, the Committee de-sanctioned the project Sale of ready-to-eat fish through Fish on Wheels( FISHFED) and approved the diversion of the sanctioned/released amount of Rs.153.00 lakh to the other project 'Renovation of Govt. Fish Farm, Kausalyagang for enhancing Fingerling Production under RKVY',

#### 10. **RPRC**

1. Mass propagation of Local Musa varieties of Odisha, Commercialize using Tissue Culture Techniques and enhance fruit self-life in Banana.
2. Establishment of mass propagation and breeding facility for orchids.

RPRC had requested for re-appropriation of fund under some budget heads i.e. Rs. 3,33, 614.00, Rs. 3.30 lakh and Rs.3.70 lakh respectively.

The Committee discussed with reference to the recommendation of SLPSC held on 19.09.19 and allowed the re-appropriation sought by RPRC.

Further, the Development Commissioner asked Director, Horticulture to sign agreement with both RPRC and OUAT regarding purchase of all the tissue culture banana plantlets to be supplied under different schemes with subsidy component. As they are funded under RKVY, such plantlets may be procured at less than the prevailing market price without imposing any tender condition.

#### 11. **IMAGE**

##### 1. **Construction of Farmers' Hostel of IMAGE.**

1. Director, IMAGE Director, had requested to utilize the unspent balance of RS. 60.07 lakh under the project 'KrushakSachetanata' Program to utilize in furnishing of the rooms of the hostel, training halls and for construction of approach and peripheral road under the project 'Construction of Farmers' Hostel, IMAGE'.

The Committee allowed the inter project diversion and asked to intimate the same to GoI.

#### 12. **SERICULTURE**

1. Development of Tasar Sericulture
2. Maintenance of ongoing projects (4<sup>th</sup> year maintenance for 275 hectare plantation).

Director, Sericulture has requested enhance the cost norm of plantation in the above two projects based on the cost norm followed by Forest & Environment Department.

The Committee discussed on the hike in labour rate as well as the increase in cost of inputs for production of planting materials as well as maintenance of plantation. It allowed the proposal of Sericulture to increase the cost norm without increasing the total project cost, thus reducing the volume of operation.

#### 13. **ICAR-NRRI**

NRRI had requested for time extension of the following projects till March, 2121 without requirement of any additional amount

1. Establishing a State of the Art Pesticide Residue Laboratory in Odisha: for its Optimum and Safe Use.
2. Setting up of model bio fertilizer production unit for supply of quality bio-inoculants for rice and rice-based cropping system in Odisha.
3. Development & Demonstration of Rice Based Integrated Farming System for Livelihood Security of Small and Marginal Farmers in Coastal Odisha.
4. IT Enabled Self-Sufficient Sustainable Seed System for Rice(4S4R).
5. Bio Bank: Production and promotion of bio control agents and entrepreneurship development in aspirational districts of Odisha.
6. Strengthening Entrepreneurs in Marketing and Export of Value Added Agricultural Products by Establishing a State-of-Art Quality Assessment Laboratory in Odisha.

The Committee discussed the proposal with reference to the recommendation of SLSPSC held on 19.09.19 and allowed the time extension.

7. Further, the Committee approved the inter componential change suggested by NRRI in 2 projects, 'Strengthening Entrepreneurs in Marketing and Export of Value Added Agricultural Products by Establishing a State-of-Art Quality Assessment Laboratory in Odisha.' and 'Setting up of model bio fertilizer production unit for supply of quality bio-inoculants for rice and rice-based cropping system in Odisha' based on the recommendation of SLSPSC held on 19.09.19.

**In order to make impact assessment of all the research projects implemented by ICAR and CG Group institutes, the Chairman of the Committee suggested Principal Secretary, Department of Agriculture and FE to make provision for Peer Review, in which Experts from OUAT will remain as key members. The impact assessment report may be placed before the next SLSC as 1st agenda.**

#### 14. OMFED

##### **14.1 Online payment to dairy cooperative farmers OMFED.**

The project was sanctioned in 2017-18. M.D OMFED submitted a revised proposal in which instead of purchasing 738 nos. of tablet and other hardwires, OMFED will install 240 nos. of Automatic Milk Collection System, (AMC) at 240 Dairy Cooperative Societies (DCS) with implementation of Entrepreneur Resource Planning (ERP) system, keeping the initial budget intact. The Committee discussed on the advantage of ERP and AMC and taking into consideration its advantage over the existing project, it approved the revised proposal of OMFED.

##### **2. Creation of dairy Infrastructure to handle enhanced Milk procurement by OMFED.**

M.D OMFED informed that out of the total budget of Rs. 522.24 lakhs in the above project, there is saving/surplus amount of Rs. 86.99 lakhs, which OMFED wants to utilise for procuring D.G set in Sambalpur dairy costing Rs. 70.00 lakh and Construction of Ice-cream deep freezer room of 10 MT capacity costing Rs. 13.85 lakh in Angul dairy.

Realising the need of the proposed infrastructure, the Committee approved the proposal.

#### 15. OSSC

### **1. Modernization of Seed Processing Plant.**

1. Under the said project, there was provision of for installation of 34 nos Electrical Panel Board with an amount of Rs. 102.00 lakhs and an amount of Rs. 425.00 lakhs for installation of automatic weighing and bagging machines.
2. M.D OSSC informed that after installation of Dust Aspiration System, Gravity Separator and Auto Weighing Bagging Machines, the electrical demand increased. So, he requested the Committee to allow the budget on the above two components for up-gradation of the existing 63 KVA Substation to 100 KVA.

The Committee after discussing on the need of such deviation approved the revised proposal of OSSC.

### **2. Strengthening of Seed Processing Plant.**

1. In the original project an amount of Rs. 12.00 lakhs was approved for shifting of one processing machinery. However, the actual amount spent for shifting 5 such unit came to Rs.60.00 lakh, which was accommodated from other components.
2. Similarly, for Construction of Seed Processing Plant Building an amount was Rs. 400.00 lakhs was approved. But, OSSC had undertaken construction of 4 nos of such buildings at a cost of Rs. 423.81 lakhs considering the requirement and availability of space. The extra expenditure was accommodated from the surplus amount of some other components in the same project.
3. M.D OSSC requested the Committee to give post-facto approval for such inter componential diversion. The Committee after detail discussion accorded post facto approval since the execution cost is within the approved budget.

### **16. Approval for Utilization of Refund Amount of 2018-19 and Accrued Interest Lying with IMAGE**

1. The Committee was apprised about the existing financial position under RKVY. The amount lying with IMAGE by way of refund of unspent amount by certain agencies is Rs.140998947 .00 (14 cr. 9 lakh)
2. Similarly, the accrued interest money as refunded by some implementing agencies from the year 2012-13 to 2018-19 is Rs.382330774 .00 (38 cr. 23 lakh).
3. The Committee was requested to allow the Nodal Department to utilise the same in some sanctioned project. The Committee approved utilization of the refund unspent amount of Rs.140998947 .00. But in regards to the accrued interest, it asked the Nodal Department to write to GoI for necessary approval.

### **17. Director, AH & VS (Sub-Scheme)**

1. **Animal Health Sub-Scheme: Rabies Vaccination in Canines under RKVY-RAFTAAR.**

The Sub-scheme was approved with reference to the recommendation of SLPSCheld on 19.09.2019


### **18. Any other issues with permission of the chair**

1. The Committee instructed the Implementing Agencies to complete the project within the stipulated time and budgeted amount without asking for repeated time extension and revalidation.



2. The Principal Secretary, Department of A&FE insisted upon the implementing agencies to take utmost care while submitting DPR for new project proposal along with checklist prescribed, land documents, design and estimate of the proposed infrastructure.
3. The Principal Secretary also emphasized the importance of value-added Agri-business projects under RKVY & RAFTAR in PPP mode for which funds have been earmarked. As such, there is need for hiring a PPP consultant to facilitate the scrutiny of such projects and their implementation, the cost of which will be met from administrative expenses.
4. Similarly, Principal Secretary apprised the committee about the need of hiring a PFMS/ Accounts Expert and a Geo-tagging Expert for smooth functioning of RKVY projects. The Committee approved the hiring of PFMS/ Accounts consultant. But with regards to geo-tagging Expert, it advised the Nodal Department to utilise the service of ORSAC.
5. The Principal Secretary apprised the Committee that a Third Party Evaluation of the projects under RKVY is going on and the report of the said agency will be presented in the next meeting of SLSC.










